### GRADING SESSION REQUIREMENTS

10 <sup>th</sup> Kyu White Belt – 9 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Yellow Belt	– 12 sessions
9 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Yellow Belt – 8 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Orange Belt	– 18 sessions
8 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Orange Belt – 7 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Red Belt	– 18 sessions
7 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Red Belt – 6 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Green Belt	– 24 sessions
6 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Green Belt – 5 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Blue Belt	– 24 sessions
5 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Blue Belt – 4 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Purple Belt	– 30 sessions
4 <sup>th</sup> Kyu Purple Belt – 3 <sup>rd</sup> Kyu Brown Belt	– 30 sessions
3 <sup>rd</sup> Kyu Brown Belt – 2 <sup>nd</sup> Kyu Brown Belt	– 36 sessions
2 <sup>nd</sup> Kyu Brown Belt – 1 <sup>st</sup> Kyu Brown Belt	– 36 sessions

Selection to 1<sup>st</sup> Dan Black Belt is at the Chief Instructor's discretion

These are the **minimum** session requirements for each grade, and students should be aware that reaching the required amount of sessions does not guarantee selection for the grading assessment.

The session requirements are set so that the junior grades can be attempted at successive grading assessments with average attendance of one session per week. Once past the junior grades, students will either need to increase their attendance to meet the requirements, or wait to attempt their next grade at the subsequent grading assessment.

Senior grade students (Brown belts) should be attending as many sessions and courses as possible, ideally two sessions per week.
